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Dear Valued CERT Members and Leaders,

The Florida CERT Association will be hosting a fabulous disaster drill at Universal Studios in Orlando on Saturday, November 12, 2016. If you have been to a drill at this location in the past, you will know that is one you will not want to miss.

Universal Studios will be closing off the New York section of their park so that our CERT members can train utilizing skills they have previously learned. You can participate as a victim or a responder, the choice is yours. Either way, all of the forms in this packet must be completed and signed and mailed with a check to the address on the bottom of the form **NO LATER THAN OCTOBER 31st**.

We have included maps to the gated employee parking lot where you will go through security. You **MUST** pre-register for this drill or you may not be cleared through the security checkpoint. Each person in the vehicle must have all of their registration paperwork submitted in advance so that security knows to allow you access into the employee parking lot. In addition, each person in the vehicle must be pre-registered and have photo ID in order to be cleared at the checkpoint.

Please read the Participant's Requirement List enclosed in this packet so that you are familiar with what you can and cannot do while on Universal Studios property.

Please help us spread the word by sharing this information with your CERT members. It has been a long time since we have had a drill at Universal Studios. As we have more and more successful events as an organization, it opens doors for us to provide bigger and better drills and events for our members in the future.

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Participant's Requirement List

1. Photo I.D. and early submission of drivers name, will be required for entry of the vehicle to get a Universal parking pass.
2. CERT I.D. and vest will be visible and must be worn at all times.
3. **NO WEAPONS OF ANY TYPE WILL BE ALLOWED** on Universal property - for example, but not limited to the following: knives of any length, no box cutters, no firearms, no pointed scissors, anything that may be construed as a weapon. You may be searched upon arrival or go through a security screening process. Universal is using metal detectors and bag checks for everyone coming on property, this also includes their employees.
4. If you are not registered to attend you may not be allowed to enter Universal Studios property.
5. Parking is limited as Universal is still active.
6. Any and ALL injuries, overheated persons etc. will / shall be reported.
7. Any and ALL unsafe actions will be stopped and reported if necessary.
8. Any unruly participants will be escorted off property and are subject to being charged and or arrested.
9. Any and all forms of Social Media will be encouraged but will not hinder the drill.
10. **Photos of behind the scenes or back of house and any construction sites (back of Universal) is expressly prohibited, you may be asked to leave by Universal Security.**

Arrival Times, Welcome, Team Briefings

1. Looking for around 2000 victims. You can start arriving around 1900 hrs. (7:00 pm).
2. Victim's clothes will be stained and may be torn or cut.
3. Victims need to wear old clothing due to moulage they will be stained and or torn.
4. Looking for around 1000 Rescuers. You can start arriving around 1930 hrs. (7:30 pm) Meet and greet, and social time.
5. Welcoming and introductions and safety briefing start at 2030 hrs. (8:30 pm)
6. We will provide the water for the drill, Universal will provide coolers and ice.
Remember to pre-hydrate before you arrive. Put an extra bottle of water in your CERT bag
7. We will be providing the Moulage for the Victims.
8. Drill will be active from 2100 till 2300 hrs.
9. Universal Studios **ALL PARTICIPANTS** must be off Universal property by midnight 0000 hrs.

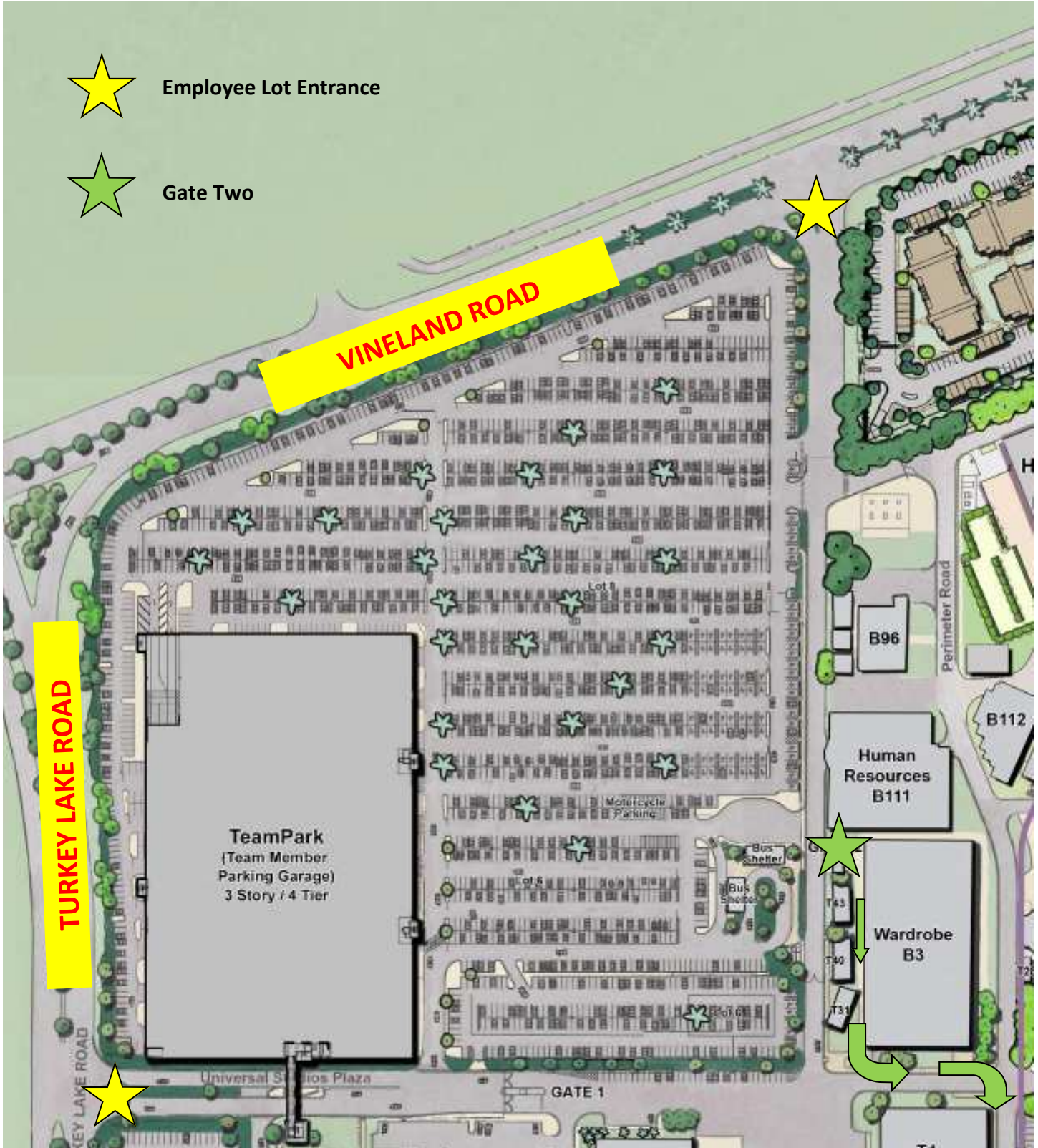

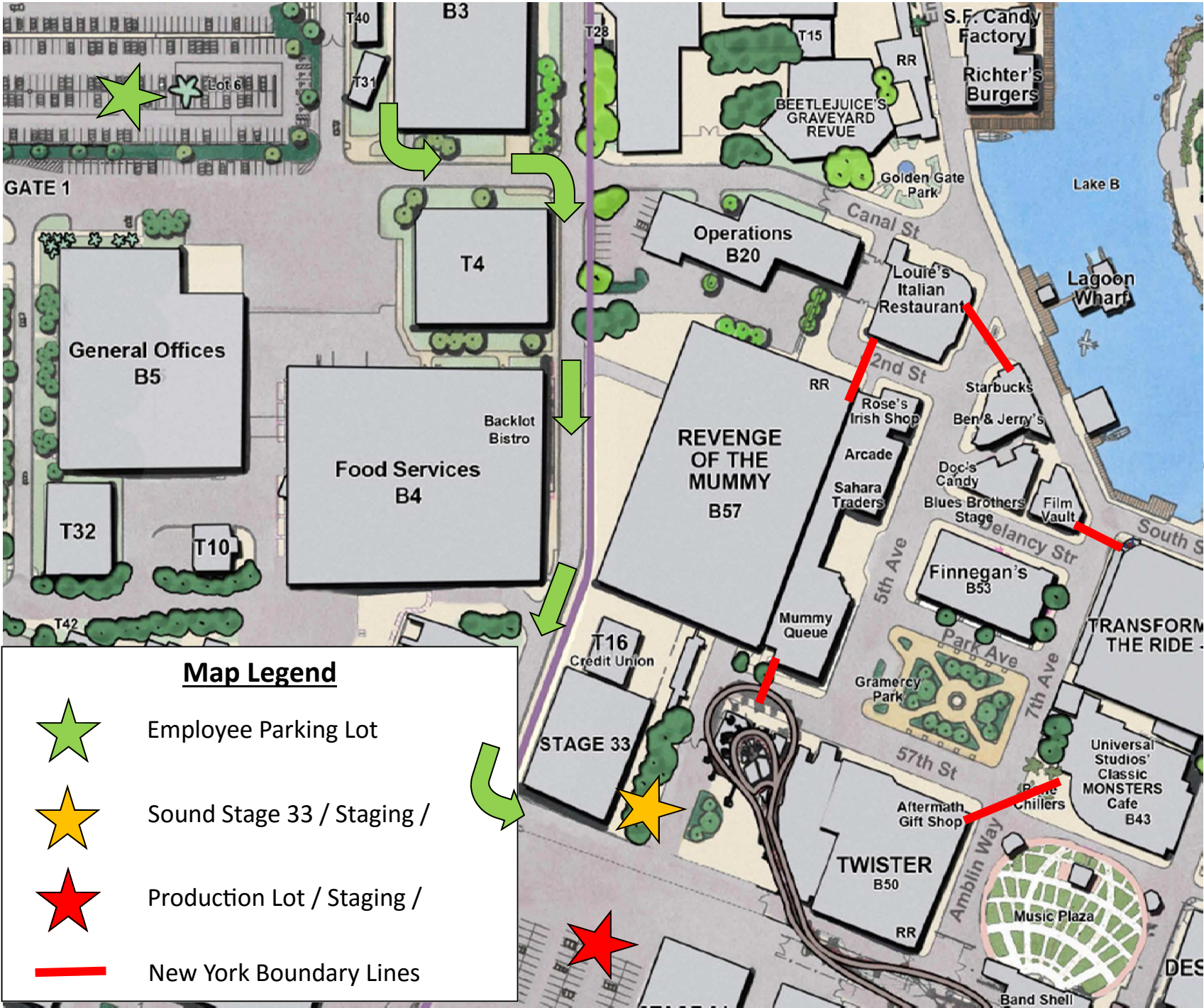
